The Quaker presence at Hay Festival 2018 will include us staffing a display stand for 11 consecutive days. The main role of volunteers will be to talk about Quakerism with confidence and enthusiasm, encouraging people to take away literature and perhaps attend worship in their home town.

We are looking for volunteers who are excited to talk about Quakerism and be a confident Quaker presence. There is no on-site car access. We particularly need Welsh speakers on these dates: 24, 25 May and 2,3 June 2018. On Thursday 24 and Friday 25 May the majority of visitors are school groups. So on those days volunteers will need to be confident in speaking to primary and secondary school pupils.

Volunteers will need to self-cater for all meals and make any necessary parking and accommodation arrangements. Volunteers will usually be able to take a brief break during quite moments of the three hour shift. You will need to be agile enough to walk across the large and uneven festival site and to stand for 15 to 20 minutes at a time. Wheelchair access may be possible.
